Dear Teachers, Parents and Dancers,

On behalf of the Jackie O'Leary School of Irish Dancing, we are delighted to welcome you to Féile na Mí Open Feis 2010.

We look forward to welcoming both old and new friends and extend an especially warm welcome to those travelling from overseas.

Our Preliminary Championships this year will be incorporated in our Open Championships with a separate overall result being given. There will be no separate fee for Preliminary Championships. The cost will be included in the Open Championship fee. Please see rules page for eligibility to enter Preliminary Championships.

All dancers will complete all three rounds. There will be no recall.

Sashes / pennants and trophies will be awarded to the top five dancers in Open Championships and Preliminary Championships. Trophies will be awarded for first place in all solos. As last year, there will be separate boys' championships.

A dedicated practice area will be available. All Championships will be held in the main hall on a special purpose-built stage. The set round will take place in a separate hall. The results will be announced in the main hall.

We have a great panel of adjudicators from Great Britain and Ireland as well as excellent musicians to provide the best of music for all the dancers.

We are delighted to be returning again to our superb venue, The Marriott Hotel, Ashbourne, which is situated within easy reach of Dublin Airport and just off the new N2 bypass (direct main route to airport). The hotel will offer a shuttle service to and from Dublin Airport. This must be prebooked directly with the hotel.

The hotel offers excellent dining facilities, serving hot and cold food all day in relaxed, informal surroundings. A teacher's lounge will also be available serving complimentary refreshments over the two days.

As in previous years, we will have a number of stalls catering for all of your dancing needs. A full championship results service will be provided with marks packs for sale.

We look forward to meeting you all over the two days and thank you for your continued support of our Feis.

RIALACHA NA FEILE

1. Entries will only be accepted from teachers currently registered with An Coimisiún le Rince Gaelacha.
2. Age will be reckoned from the 1st January 2010
3. Competitors should be ready to dance 30 minutes before the scheduled time of competition.
4. The system for adjudication will be the same as used at Oireachtas Rince na hÉireann.
5. Traditional set dances must be chosen from the following list: **St. Patrick's Day, The Blackbird, Job of Journeywork, Garden of Daisies, King of the Fairies, Three Sea Captains and Jockey to the Fair.**
6. In Craobh Rince Ceilí, teams must perform any 8 hand from Ar Rince Foirne.
7. The Feis committee reserves the right a) to use relief adjudicators, b) to alternate competitions, if it becomes necessary, in order to maintain the smooth running of the Feis and c) to transfer competitions to a different hall.
8. Objections must be lodged in writing within one hour of the announcement of a competition result and be accompanied by a fee of €25.
9. No block, en pointe, stationary or moving is allowed to be performed for ages up to and including the under 12 age group.
10. Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children, at all times, whilst attending Féile Na Mí.
11. Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic/manual means, e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder, commercial film, with/without flash enhancement, is expressly forbidden in competition
12. An Coimisiún rules will apply if disputes arise that are not covered by the above rules.
13. To enter a Preliminary Championship, dancers must have been eligible to enter Meán Grad for those particular dances on January 1st 2008. Dancers are not eligible to enter a Preliminary Championship if they have previously won a Preliminary Championship.

By Car:

Directions from Dublin Airport:

Take the M1 towards the M50. Take the M50 southbound and leave at Exit 5, the N2 towards Derry. Keep on following the N2 bypassing Ashbourne Village, continue to roundabout at end of bypass. The hotel is situated on the 2nd exit of the roundabout.

* Estimated taxi fare: 30.00 EUR (one way).

Directions from Dublin City Centre:

From O'Connell Street follow the signs for N2 towards Derry. Keep on following the N2 bypassing Ashbourne Village, continue to last roundabout. The hotel is situated on the 2nd exit of the roundabout.

Directions from South:

Join the M50 at N7 Red Cow Interchange. Take the M50 northbound and leave at Exit 5, the N2 towards Derry. Keep on following the N2 bypassing Ashbourne Village, continue to roundabout at end of bypass. The hotel is situated on the 2nd exit of the roundabout.

Directions from West:

Join the M50 at the M4/N4 Lucan Interchange. Take the M50 northbound and leave at Exit 5, the N2 towards Derry. Keep on following the N2 bypassing Ashbourne Village, continue to roundabout at end of bypass. The hotel is situated on the 2nd exit of the roundabout.
