I'm very happy, on behalf of Comhairle Laighean, to send you the syllabus for Oireachtas Rince Laighean 2019. "The Leinsters" is the most important occasion in our regional calendar and we, as a council, are looking forward to welcoming you to the Oireachtas and to your continued support. We're also hoping that we'll all enjoy a great weekend of dancing.

The event went really well last year and we have booked the National Sports Complex again for our championships again this year.

We have also introduced a preliminary championship. Dancers will dance a light dance (reel or slip-jig) and a heavy dance (heavy jig or hornpipe). They will be judged by three adjudicators and three results will be given. Two adjudicators will be taken from the floor each day to make up the third adjudicator on each panel.

We are using the online entry system as we have for the past three years. Any teacher who is new to this process or who needs any help, please do not hesitate to contact us and we will assist you. The website is [www.feisentry.com](http://www.feisentry.com) and will be open from Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2019 to Tuesday 21st May 2019. Please try and submit your entries in good time in case there are any technical issues you may encounter.

Please note that **all** entries submitted must be paid for by the closing date - 29<sup>th</sup> May 2019. Entry fees can be paid by **online transfer** to the Comhairle Laighean bank account. Please email Marcus Maloney ([marcuspmaloney@gmail.com](mailto:marcuspmaloney@gmail.com)) with your confirmation email from feisentry indicating that you have availed of the online transfer facility. Remember to state your name or dancing school in the message for the receiver.

If you are unable to make the online transfers Cheques, bank drafts or postal orders can be accepted. We will accept entry fees for Oireachtas Rince Laighean only from teachers, individual cheques from parents will not be accepted.

Any additional entries accepted on the day will be subject to an increased entry fee of €1 per dance to a maximum of €5 per dancer. This will be **STRICTLY** adhered to. We urge all teachers to avail of the pre entry system in place so the event can run to a smooth pre-determined timetable.

### Rules for Graded Competitions

1. In Bun Grád 2 Hand and 3 Hand Competitions, dancers must have competed in at least one solo dance competition in Bun or Tús Grád at the Oireachtas. Basic Steps only may be used.
2. In Bun Grád Céilí Dancing, i.e. 4, 6, or 8 Hands, competitions are confined to those competitors who have never won a 1<sup>st</sup> place for that particular dance in any age or grade. Dancers who have won Open Championships are not permitted to compete in this section as per the rules of An Coimisiún in relation to Bun Grád Competitions.
3. **No dancer may be a member of more than one team in any one competition.**  
Bun Grád competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1<sup>st</sup> prize in that particular dance in any grade, **including two-hand and three-hand competitions**. Bun Grád steps must be performed.
4. Tús Grád competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1<sup>st</sup> prize in Tús, Lár, Meán or Ard Grád. Tús steps must be danced.
5. Lár Grád competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1<sup>st</sup> prize in that particular dance in their age or higher in Lár, Meán or Ard Grád.
6. Meán Grád competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1<sup>st</sup> prize in that particular dance in their age or higher in Meán or Ard Grád.
7. Make up is not permitted in Bun and Tús Grád up to and including under 12 competitions.
8. Competitors in all ages in Bun and Tús Grád competitions may only wear class costume, skirt and blouse or appropriate civilian clothing. **Low cut tops or short tight skirts are not permitted**. Failure to comply with rules 7 and 8 may lead to disqualification from competition.
9. **In all Bun and Tús Grád Competitions, the number of dancers who will be re-graded to Tús and Lár or Meán Grád respectively will be determined by the number who compete in the competition according to the following table:-**

1- 20 competitors	1 <sup>st</sup> place regraded
21- 40 competitors	1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> place regraded
41 and over	1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> place regraded.
10. The winners of under five Bun Grád competitions will still be eligible to dance Bun Grád in older age groups for the dance or dances they have won under 5. This exception only applies to the Bun Grád under 5 competitors.

All dancers will dance one light dance (**reel or slip jig**) and one heavy dance (**heavy jig or hornpipe**). Three results will be given.

## Rules for preliminary competitions

A dancer may enter a preliminary competition if:

- a) They have not placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in an Open Championship which has been judged by three or more adjudicators, in the current calendar year.
- b) They have not qualified for the World Championships in 2019 or are a current medal holder
- c) They have not won a Preliminary Championship in that calendar year.

A dancer who wins a Preliminary Championship may not compete in a Preliminary Championship for the remainder of the calendar year. They may enter a Preliminary championship in the next year providing they comply with the above rules.

A dancer who wins a Preliminary Championship may not dance those dances in Mean Grád for the remainder of the calendar year.
